

WHAT ARE THE PROCEDURES IN APPLYING FOR THE PROGRAM?

Regular Application:

1. Secure Forms 1, 2, & 3 from the OU Registrar.
2. Accomplish the forms correctly and submit the same to the OU with admission requirements.
3. Applicant will be notified of status of application through text message or e-mail letter.

Online Application:

1. Log-on to <http://www.openuni-clsu.edu.ph/registration.php> and download OU Forms 1, 2 & 3.
2. Accomplish forms and send the same to OU with admission requirements.
3. Applicant will be notified through e-mail of status of application.

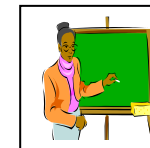
CERTIFICATE IN TEACHING



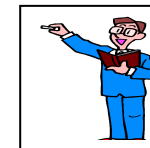
A course intended for those who wish to:



➤ Take the Licensure Examination for Teachers (LET);



➤ Teach in the elementary, secondary and tertiary levels;



➤ Establish and manage a school; and

➤ Upgrade teaching competencies.



WHAT IS THE MODE OF INSTRUCTION?

Basically, the Certificate in Teaching Program employs online and modular education. Using interactive and self-paced modules, the students are tasked to log-in on the website of the Open University.

With this mode, the program promotes personalized, flexible, and convenient self-regulated learning. There are five sessions of face-to-face interaction set during the semester/term for students who have time to come to CLSU. Otherwise, contact between learner and tutor will be through the internet.

WHAT ARE THE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS?

Prospective enrollees should be college degree holders and computer literate. They must submit the following to the CLSU OU:

1. Fully accomplished application forms;
2. Original Transcript of Records;
3. Two identical 2" x 2" recent colored pictures;
4. Photocopy of valid passport (for foreign applicants); and
5. Proof of payment of application fee.

WHAT ARE THE COURSE REQUIREMENTS?

The student has to satisfactorily complete the courses of the program and has to undergo one month pre-service teaching (practicum).

The student should be able to finish the Certificate in Teaching Program in 2 years.

WHAT SUBJECTS ARE BEING OFFERED UNDER THE PROGRAM?
